Vocabulary: Georgia O'Keefe, watercolor, grid method, subject matter, theme: (life/death)

CS1&2 F.1.AI.1 CP4AI5	Clay Pottery <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Building Monday-Tuesday</li> <li>Firing Wednesday</li> <li>Glazing Thursday</li> </ul>
Students will create a coil pot using the method demonstrated by Mrs. Callahan. Individuality/creativity is encouraged within the limits of coil pottery design.	
Vocabulary: clay, coil, felting tool, base, score, slip

CS 1&2 F.1.AI.1-6 CP4AI5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 point Perspective Name Design</li> <li>Due Friday 2.23</li> </ul>
Students will learn to use 1 point perspective to create the illusion of space. Using this method they will create their own name in 3D.	
Vocabulary: perspective, orthogonal, vanishing point, block letter, horizon line
