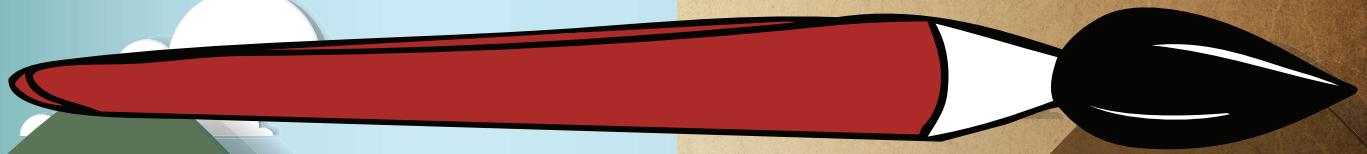

## NATURAL STATE VS. TOBACCO STATE 2014 ART CONTEST RULES

- Students in grades 9 – 12 may participate.
- Entries must be limited to one per student.
- Students must create artwork themselves with no outside assistance from parents, teachers, other adults or peers.
- Artwork should be created on 8.5" x 11" paper, using crayons, colored pencils, markers, charcoal pencils, pastels, ink pens, paints, or mixed media.
- Please staple student submission form to submitted work.
- There will be winners announced in both categories of Natural State and Tobacco State
- The contest will run in Arkansas schools from February 5 through March 28. All entries must be postmarked by March 28 to be considered.

- PLEASE NOTE: Entries will be disqualified if the following steps are not taken when mailing entries:
  1. Separate all entries by grade
  2. Complete and submit the enclosed cover form
- Artists will judge the entries, and winners will be announced by 5 p.m., on April 25, on [www.stampoutsmoking.com](http://www.stampoutsmoking.com). Following the announcement of winners, SOS will contact your school to arrange for the delivery of prizes.
- Prizes will be awarded on a statewide basis for each grade level:
  - Ninth - Twelfth Grades
    - First place - PlayStation 4
    - Second place - Go Pro Action Camera
    - Third place - Beats by Dr. Dre In-Ear Headphones
- To be eligible for the \$1,000 prize, schools must adhere to all of the above rules and submit entries collectively as a school.
- In the event that multiple schools participate at 100 percent of their student body, the winner of the \$1,000 will be drawn at random.
